Expected date of release of assessment results Report card will be issued to the student within the first 3 weeks of the following term.

Graduation (Student-requirements) Ordinarily students must pass the course and achieved 90% attendance (Student Pass students) or 80% attendance (Non-Student Pass students). All fees must be duly paid in full.
