Expected date of assessment results Report card will be issued to the student within the first release of 3 weeks of the following term.

Graduation (Student-requirements) Ordinarily students must pass the course and achieve 90% attendance (Student Pass students) or 80% attendance (Non-Student Pass students). All fees must be duly paid in full.

Expected date of conferment of award Upon request, the school will give the student a Letter of Completion following successful completion of the course, within 7 working days of the request.
