Frequency of assessment: Continual

Examinations Students to sit for continual assessments in each term of the academic year.
Students to sit for the internal IIS Examinations in Term 3.

Dates of examinations All dates of continual class tests, quizzes, practical tests (if applicable) will be informed by the teacher at least 7 days in advance through communication booklet and/or email. Students will sit for the IIS Examinations unless exempted.

Expected date of release of final exam results Report card will be issued to the student within the first 3 weeks of the following term.

Graduation (Student-requirements) Ordinarily students must pass the course and achieve 90% attendance (Student Pass students) or 80% attendance (Non-Student Pass students). All fees must be duly paid in full.

Expected date of conferment of award Upon request, the school will give the student a Letter of Completion following successful completion of the course, within 7 working days of the request. External examination award conferment date is specified by the external examination body e.g., Pearson Education Limited.
