


PRIVATE COUNSELLING SUITES



It provides leeway for educators to develop bespoke programmes to accommodate each student while also challenging them to achieve more.

CAMBRIDGE & PEARSON EDEXCEI

IIS prides itself in delivering a high-quality curriculum that can be tailored to fit our students' needs. As a Cambridge International School and a Pearson Edexcel Approved Centre, our curriculum supports students to develop a range of transferable skills such as problem-solving, critical thinking, leadership and collaboration. Students enrolled in the Enrichment programmes (3-5 years old) up to Grade 9, prepare for higher-level learning as they advance to take the Pearson Edexcel IGCSE Examinations after two-years of study in Grades 10 and 11. Building upon their knowledge, students are fostered to further apply their learning in the Cambridge AS & A Levels. The AS & A Levels are globally recognised international academic qualifications for our students in Grade 12 and 13. IIS implements our AS & A Level programmes through the highly reputed Cambridge Assessment International Education examination body. Both our IGCSE and AS/A Level programmes provide the skills and knowledge needed for students to progress onto university and into employment.
