Examinations/ assessments Students to sit for continual assessment such as class tests, quizzes, practical tests in each term of the academic year.
IIS examination is applicable for Grade 3, 5 & 8.
External examination is applicable for Grade 6, 9, 10 and/ or 11, AS & A level.

Dates of examinations/ assessments All assessment dates & examination dates will be informed by the teacher at least 7 days in advance through communication booklet and/or email.

Expected date of release assessment/ examination results IIS assessment or examination results will be released to the student within the first 3 weeks of the following term. External examination award conferment date is specified by the external examination body. Eg: Pearson Education Limited.

Graduation requirements Ordinarily students must pass the course and achieve 90% attendance (Student Pass students) or 80% attendance (Non-Student Pass students). All fees must be duly paid in full.

Expected date of award Upon request, the school will give the student Certificate/ Letter of completion of the course within 7 working days of the request. External examination award conferment date is specified by the external examination body e.g., Pearson Education Limited.
